I won't call you today

Will you call me as soon as possible?



PROMISES

I promise I will be in time

PREDICTIONS

It will snow

OFFER

I will collect you from the airport

THREATS

I will tell your father if you don't stop

REFUSALS

I won't eat unhealthy food

IMMEDIATE DECISIONS

I will eat an apple

GOING TO

PRIOR PLANS

I am going to play a volleyball match

PREDICTIONS (WITH EVIDENCE)

Look at those clouds, it is going to rain

SOMETHING IS ABOUT TO HAPPEN

The volume is too high, it is going to make a terrible noise

PAY ATTENTION

I'll have a tea - instead of using "will"

IT IS POSSIBLE TO SAY:

I' m gonna fly to New York - instead of using "going to"
