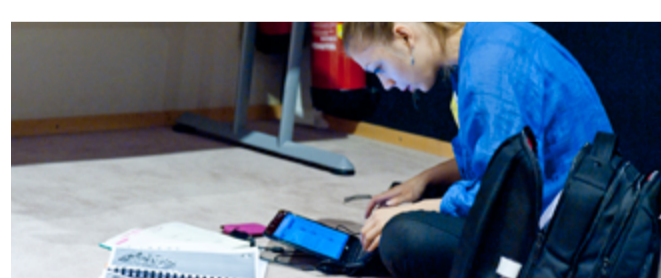
SHAPE THE EYE PROGRAMME
