## The Genitive Case

The genitive case is used to show possession. It is usually created by adding 's to a noun not ending in s, and ' to a noun ending in s, or by preceding a word with "of."

### Examples:

- Mary's iPhone
- The top of the mountain
- Chris' homework
- The tail of the dog
