DEBATING

PURPOSE - > TO **PERSUADE**

- 2 TEAMS: the *proposing* team and the *opposing* team. Three or four speakers per team.
- 1 MOTION (TOPIC) (always in statement form)
- 2 TEAMS: FOR or AGAINST THE MOTION

AGREE OR DISAGREE with the motion

I propose the motion "..."

I oppose the motion "..."

Style: can be formal ("Madame Chairman, fellow students, members of the public...") or less formal.

ELEMENTS:

- STATE YOUR POSITION: "I propose the motion that "...."
- USE EXAMPLES, CONTEXTS, SITUATIONS, COMPARISONS
- EXAGGERATE (drama)
- CITE DATA/FACTS
- USE RHETORICAL QUESTIONS
- HUMOUR, IRONY, SARCASM...

+ A SENSE OF <u>URGENCY !!!</u>

IMPORTANT:

A STRONG OPENING AND A STRONG CLOSING.
